- This provides an overview for students about the world they live in – bringing a consciousness to their digital world. It is important for students to understand the responsibilities they have when they use and share information on the internet.
- The paragraph with a link to legal and ethical reminds students about their responsibilities as a digital citizen. It might be useful to have a discussion of what this involves - ask students for a definition of 'ethical' and 'legal' and how it relates to their lives after they read the link.
